# Club Policy No. 6 - Equipment Policy

Good quality equipment (player clothing, footballs, first aid kits, etc.) is essential to running a successful football club. The purchase and maintenance of equipment is one of the BJFC's major expenses. Loss of equipment, (jumpers in particular) can result in an unnecessary large club expense.

# Allocation and returning of equipment

### **Player jumpers**

Players will be allocated a team jumper at the start of each season.

## Officials

Each season the Club allocates equipment to Coaches and Team Managers e.g. interchange jackets, match and training balls, first aid kit, goal umpire's jackets and flags, drink bottles, etc.

The equipment distribution is usually in the form of a number of items (and often in bags) given to the Team Manager and Coach at the start of each season. Equipment can be replaced or topped up, but all requests must go through the Treasurer.

As far as possible, the BJFC looks for low cost options in purchasing equipment, which means we sometimes purchase items in bulk and will have ready replacements available. We can often purchase items cheaper than the usual retail prices, so it is very important that Team Managers and Coaches put all requests through the Treasurer no matter how small the item might be.

Coaches and Team Managers must take care of all allocated equipment.

As soon as the season ends but no later than 1 October all equipment must be returned to the Club.
